# KEYNOTE SPEAKER

## AMBASSADOR DESSIMA WILLIAMS



Ambassador Dessima Williams has had a notable career in education, community service, and as a diplomat for more than 40 years. She has been a voice for gender and social equality, and climate change—particularly the impact of climate change on Small Island Developing States. The ambassador has represented Grenada and global civil society at the Conference of Parties meetings for the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change meetings since 2009.

Ambassador Williams got her start in diplomacy in 1979 when she was appointed ambassador and permanent representative of Grenada to the Organization of American States. She served as Grenada's ambassador and permanent representative to the UN from 2009 to 2013, and was the special advisor to the president of the UN on the Sustainable Development Goals from 2016 to 2017.

After graduating from St. Joseph's Convent, Grenville, Ambassador Williams moved to the US to complete her bachelor's degree at the University of Minnesota. She then moved to Washington, DC, for both her master's degree and doctorate in international relations from American University.

She held faculty positions in the Department of Sociology and in the Heller School of Social Policy at Brandeis University in Massachusetts, from 1992 to 2005 and was the main advisor for undergraduate and Caribbean students while there. From 2014 to 2016, she served as an adjunct professor on gender and sustainable development within the School of Arts and Sciences at St. George's University and has been a past speaker at the Schools of Medicine and Veterinary Medicine commencement ceremonies in New York.

In 1996, she was a member of the group that co-founded the Grenada Education and Development Program (GREDED), which helps support rural, school-aged children to attend secondary school and college.

Ambassador Williams has spent the past year remodeling her family's business, the Rainbow Inn—an eco-tourism guesthouse started by her mother more than 40 years ago. Today, she administers the Inn and GREDED while also serving as an elected partner on the board of the Caribbean Natural Resource Institute (CANARI).

# VALEDICTORIAN, SCHOOL OF ARTS AND SCIENCES NAMRATHA GURUVAIAH SRIDHARA



At the age of five, Namratha Guruvaiah Sridhara moved with her family from India to the Bahamas, where she completed her primary and secondary school education at Queen's College, Nassau. While there, she excelled in both school and national examinations, earning a perfect 4.0 GPA. Additionally, she was a member of the Students Pursuing Advanced Rigorous Courses program (SPARC), the Interact Club, and the School Beautification Committee before graduating as the school's valedictorian in 2017.

Following in her sister Nanditha's footsteps, Ms. Guruvaiah Sridhara enrolled as a pre-medical student in St. George's University's seven-year Doctor of Medicine program. She is expected to graduate with her MD in 2024. With both her parents being physicians, she has always had an interest in the sciences and a strong passion for a career in medicine, believing it to be the best tool to serve others in need. While at SGU, she has been a member of several student organizations, including Women in Medicine and the Surgery Club, and has served as the Urban Humanitarian Projects co-chair for the Iota Epsilon Alpha (IEA) International Honor Society this past semester. She will continue to serve as a grand marshal for the August 2021 term.

As she completes her journey toward earning her MD, Ms. Guruvaiah Sridhara—a firm believer that the harder she works, the luckier she will be—has again proven her excellence by maintaining a 4.0 GPA and was selected as the 2021 School of Arts and Sciences valedictorian. Ms. Guruvaiah Sridhara credits her success to her parents, her sister, and her strong support system at SGU.

# CLASS SPEAKER, SCHOOL OF GRADUATE STUDIES SAMANTHA ANTOINE-PURCELL



Samantha Antoine-Purcell, MBA '18, is the founding collaborator and principal at the St. George's Institute, a new secondary educational institution that is Grenada's first collaborative secondary school.

Ms. Antoine-Purcell's love for education was evident early on. After graduating St. Joseph's Convent, St. George's, in 2000, she went on to attend T.A. Marryshow Community College to complete two consecutive programs—an associate degree in social science with education in 2002, and a

degree in collaboration with the University of the West Indies to become a secondary school teacher in 2004.

In 2010, Ms. Antoine-Purcell earned a Bachelor of Science in accounting and international business from St. George's University, followed by a Master of Business Administration with a specialization in international business in 2018. Today, she graduates SGU with a Master of Education, specializing in curriculum, pedagogy, and leadership, which she achieved all while being fully employed in the teaching profession.

Ms. Antoine-Purcell comes from a family with a rich history in the field of education—her mother was a primary school principal and national awardee for her service to education; her father is a retired teacher and senior civil servant; her siblings are passionate educators on the island.

Her community and professional involvement spans religious, educational, and professional bodies, including the Grenada and Caribbean Associations of Principals of Secondary Schools.
