Grenada Pre-Travel Checklist Spring 2022



We can't wait to welcome you back to campus! But first, make sure you have everything on this mandatory checklist. When you have checked all boxes, you are ready to return!

TO DO BEFORE TRAVEL

- ☐ Get fully COVID-19 vaccinated
- ☐ Confirm passport valid for six months from date of arrival
- ☐ Secure airline ticket
- ☐ Complete SGU Flight Plan form
- ☐ Complete Travel Health Declaration Form
- ☐ Complete SGU electronic customs form
- ☐ Get negative PCR result within 72 hours of arrival

CARRY ON DAY OF TRAVEL

- ☐ SGU Enrollment Letter

- ☐ Travel Health Declaration Form
- ☐ Proof of vaccination card

GET FULLY COVID-19 VACCINATED

- Anyone entering Grenada either by air or sea must be fully vaccinated with a WHO-approved vaccination.
 Exemptions to fully vaccinated status are: Citizens,
 Residents, Persons under 13, Diplomats, Airline crew on layover.
- As part of our plan for a safe return to campus life, COVID-19 vaccinations will be required for all students, faculty, staff, administrators, vendors, and visitors on campus.
- All students must be vaccinated in the country in which they are residing.
- Travelers to Grenada are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose in a two-dose series, such as the Astra Zeneca, Pfizer, Moderna, Sinopharm or Sinovac vaccines and 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson and Johnson's Janssen vaccine. Booster shots are not currently required.
- Keep your COVID-19 vaccination card in a safe place.
 Take a photo with your phone as back-up.
- When you travel, pack it in your carry-on luggage and be ready to show your vaccine card to immigration authorities in Grenada.

VALID PASSPORT

• You will need a valid passport. Grenada requires passports to be valid for six months beyond the date of entry.

SGU FLIGHT PLAN FORM

- We have created a secure form so you can update us on your travel plans back to campus.
- When you have booked your flight to Grenada, visit
 the <u>Flight Plan Back to Campus portal</u> and log in with
 your SGU credentials to submit your flight details.

TRAVEL HEALTH DECLARATION FORM

- Airlines and the Ministry of Health in Grenada require all passengers to have a Travel Health Declaration Form before arriving in Grenada.
- Visit Grenada's <u>Ministry of Health website</u> and select Travel Health Declaration Form to complete the form.
- On the form, you will need to confirm that you have a negative PCR test or NAAT test taken within 72 hours (3 days) of arrival in Grenada.
- The form will also prompt you to upload your vaccine card or certificate.
- Once complete, you will receive immediate email approval for travel to Grenada. Please check your email and print your Travel Health Declaration.
- You will be required to present your Travel Health Declaration to the airline upon arrival in Grenada, along with a copy of your negative PCR test result.

SGU ELECTRONIC CUSTOMS FORM

- If you are travelling to Grenada for the first time, SGU will cover the customs fees for up to three electronic devices that you register, for example, your cell phone, laptop and/or tablet.
- Bring a receipt for any additional devices if you have one. If you do not have a receipt, the custom fee will be calculated based on the estimated value of the device.
- Complete this form to register your devices.

COPY OF NEGATIVE PCR RESULT WITHIN 72 HOURS OF ARRIVAL

- You will also need to have a negative PCR test within 72 hours of your arrival to Grenada.
- Keep this handy when you check-in as you will need to present your test results prior to boarding your flight to Grenada.

SGU ENROLLMENT LETTER

• SGU will email you this letter, which is addressed to the immigration authorities in Grenada and outlines your course of study. You will be required to present a physical copy of this letter to immigration upon your arrival in Grenada. If you do not receive this letter at least 7 days before your travel date, please contact us as noted below.

VISA UPON ARRIVAL LETTER

• SGU will email you a copy of the Visa Upon Arrival Letter. SGU students do not require a visa to enter Grenada. They will be issued a visa upon arrival. This letter states the policy in case you are asked about this as you travel to Grenada. If you do not receive this letter at least 7 days before your travel date, please reach out using the contact information below.

UPON ARRIVAL IN GRENADA

- Fully vaccinated travellers will not be required to get tested or guarantine on arrival.
- A health official may ask you to take a test if it is deemed necessary.

- An SGU ambassador will greet and direct you upon arrival. Once you have cleared Immigration and Customs, transportation to your dorm room on campus will be arranged and paid for by SGU.
- If you are residing off campus, you can use the <u>Grenada Airport Taxi Services</u>, personal or other types of transportation. Please be prepared to cover the cost of transportation to your accommodation.
- Grenada Airports Authority requires anyone picking up passengers to be fully vaccinated and show proof of vaccination.

TRAVELLING WITH MINORS

- If you are traveling with children 12 years of age or older who are unvaccinated, you will need to follow the entry protocols for unvaccinated travelers.
- You must have a confirmed reservation at a <u>Pure Safe</u> <u>Travel Property</u>.
- Visit Grenada's <u>Ministry of Health website</u> and select Pay Online COVID-19 Test to pre-pay for your tests upon arrival.
- The SARS CoV2 costs EC\$135.00, which is equivalent to US\$50 and will cover all tests administered at the airport.
- Complete the Travel Health Declaration Form on the <u>Ministry of Health website</u>.
- You are required to use authorized airport taxis for transportation to your quarantine accommodation.
- Travel parties treated as unvaccinated will need to quarantine for seven (7) days. On day five (5), PCR tests will be administered. If test results are negative, everyone will be medically cleared to leave the quarantine accommodation.

Please select your preference for online or in-person learning by filling out the mandatory learning selection. Log into Banner Self-Service to make your selection for the January 2022 term. If your circumstances change, you can log back in to update your selection.
