## Accommodation Guide Trinity Square, Newcastle

St. George's University (SGU) students stay in Trinity Square, a modern student housing development, during their time in Northumbria University (NU), Newcastle. SGU staff will ensure your accommodation is organized for your arrival during your enrollment. Your NU accommodation offer will automatically be issued when you receive your NU unconditional academic offer. Login to your [NU Student Portal](#) and accept your NU accommodation offer, and an apartment will be assigned to you.

## What Is Trinity Square?

**Trinity Square** is divided into eleven blocks, housing approximately 1,000 students. Enrolled students live together at the Trinity Square residence building, which is a **20 minute walk** or a **quick Metro ride** to campus.

SGU students share a self-contained apartment accommodating **five** people. You have your own double en-suite bedroom and will be allocated a single-gender apartment, where possible.

Each apartment has a shared kitchen/living space with these amenities provided

The open-plan kitchen and living room provides an ideal base for socializing with flat-mates. You can also take advantage of the generously sized communal hubs within Trinity Square.

Whether you want to wind down in the **cinema room**, revise in one of the **study pods**, or work out in the on-site **fitness suite**, you are sure to find a space to suit you in Trinity Square.

Trinity Square is an NU accommodation and is considered **on-campus** living. It is mandatory that new SGU students live on campus for the **first year** of their program or pathway. If you want to choose your own accommodation or live off-campus in Newcastle, you will need to provide a valid reason and obtain written approval from the **Dean of Students Office (DOS)** at [dosnu@sgu.edu](mailto:dosnu@sgu.edu).

## Arriving At Trinity Square

- NU provides a complimentary **Meet and Greet service** to transport you (and family members) from the below arrival points:
  - **Airport:** Newcastle International Airport, Woolsington, Newcastle NE13 8BZ
  - **Bus:** Newcastle Coach Station, St. James Boulevard, Churchill Street, Newcastle NE1 4EE
  - **Train:** Newcastle Central Station, Neville Street, Newcastle NE1 5DL
- You must book the Meet and Greet service **at least seven days** before arriving in Newcastle. To arrange your Meet and Greet service, SGU students should select the '**start term date/arrival date**' and in the '**Flight number**' box, add the following information:

## FAQ's

- **Is Trinity Square exclusively for SGU students?**  
No, but we try to house SGU students in the same blocks.
- **When can I arrive/check in to Trinity Square?**  
Students will be provided with the start date on their tenancy agreement. The tenancy agreement will be sent to you for signing after the housing offer is accepted in the NU Student Portal.
- **Is there a supermarket nearby?**  
Yes, there is a large supermarket nearby where students can buy household items and groceries.
- **When will my place in Trinity Square be guaranteed?**  
When the housing offer and tenancy agreement are signed.
- **How secure is the accommodation?**  
The reception and check-in area are always staffed 24/7 with either an onsite reception team or security personnel. In addition to this, there is also CCTV in the common room areas throughout the campus to ensure student safety.
- **Can I stay at Trinity Square for the summer holidays?**  
The tenancy agreement spans a full academic year. For an additional cost, you can request to stay at Trinity Square outside of term time, like the summer holidays, subject to availability and not guaranteed. A separate tenancy agreement is required.\*
- **What happens at the end of the tenancy agreement?**  
Students have the opportunity to renew their tenancy agreement.
