KEYNOTE SPEAKER

JOY ST. JOHN, MD, MPH



Joy St. John, MD, is executive director of the Caribbean Public Health Agency (CARPHA). Under Dr. St. John's leadership, CARPHA has led the public health response to the COVID-19 pandemic in the CARICOM region. As a result she has participated in more than 400 speaking engagements about COVID-19. CARPHA is also currently one of the partners in a project titled, "Pathway to Policy: Integrating Security and Public Health Responses to Firearms Trafficking and Violence in the Caribbean."

In 2005, Dr. St. John became the first Barbadian Chief Medical Officer of Barbados. She held this position for over 12 years, serving as the top public health advisor to the country's Minister of Health, where she was responsible for the oversight of the management of the health sector.

Dr. St. John also represented Barbados on the executive board of the World Health Organization (WHO). She later became the first Caribbean person to chair the executive board from 2012 to 2013.

In 2017, she became the Assistant Director General at the WHO headquarters in Switzerland and the first Barbadian to hold the position. There she held the Portfolio of Climate and Other Determinants of Health and successfully completed the first phase of the Climate Change and Health Small Island Developing States Initiative.

Dr. St. John has an impressive track record of achievements in public health systems management and development and health diplomacy. She has served the region with great distinction. Her firm but fair style has assured her a place in networks of practice across the world.

That I will be an advocate for patients in need and strive for justice in the care of the sick.

I now turn to my calling, promising to preserve its finest traditions, with the reward of a long experience in the joy of healing.
