Ashley Lashley is a dynamic change-maker and relentless advocate for social and environmental change. As a UNICEF Youth Advocate, CARICOM Youth Ambassador, and Miss World Barbados, Ashley has committed her life to tackling pressing global challenges.

Ashley founded “Schools Against Non-Communicable Diseases” at the age of 16 and later launched the Healthy and Environmentally-Friendly Youth (HEY) campaign, which has mobilized over 500 climate activists worldwide to take action.

Through the Ashley Lashley Foundation, which she established, she has empowered thousands of young people by providing tens of thousands of dollars for funding youth-led initiatives.

Ashley’s influence spans prestigious global platforms, including the United Nations General Assembly, Forbes, and BBC, where she amplifies the voices of youth in climate and health advocacy. She also founded the Small Island Developing States (SIDS) Global Children and Youth Action Summit and co-organized it in her role as CARICOM Youth Ambassador. In a historic milestone, Ashley introduced the first-ever CARICOM Badge for Brownies and Girl Guides, a groundbreaking initiative that promotes Caribbean citizenship, cultural pride, and youth leadership.

Whether leading the Barbados Youth Climate Action Summit, supporting SIDS communities, or empowering young girls through the CARICOM Badge, Ashley’s commitment to action is unwavering. Her leadership is not just inspiring; it’s impactful, demonstrating that with purpose, dedication, and action, young leaders can make a real difference.
